Excel Air opens hangar at Louisville airport

Excel Air Charter LLC has opened its new hangar at Louisville International Airport.

Construction on the \$2.1 million project was completed in

TRANSPORTATION April, with Abel Construction Co. Inc. serving as the contractor. The architect for the project was Bayus Design Works.

The new, 25,000-square-foot hangar can hold up to six Citation Excel jet aircraft.

The company previously was operating out of Atlantic Aviation Service, the airport's fixed-based operators hangar, sharing space with other companies. The new hangar, at 1176 Standiford Ave., is next to Atlantic Aviation.

Excel hopes that its new hangar will allow it to offer a higher level of customized and private service for charter flights, as well as giving it room to expand its fleet of two jets.
